



# Emergency Procedures Check list

## Identify we have an Emergency, Fire, Flooding, Collision

1. Announce emergency, make sure everyone on board is aware
2. Announce May Day
  - VHF radio
  - High Frequency radio
3. Activate tracking devices and move to cockpit
  - EPIRB – Unlock from holding bracket on flybridge, activate and take to cockpit
  - Garmin – unlock and activate and take to cockpit
  - Find me spot – located in Dinghy – only if time allows
4. Gather items and move to cockpit
  - 2 Ditch Bag – upstairs doghouse
  - Sea going life vest – upstairs side doghouse
  - 1 clothing backpack bag – under upstairs doghouse
  - 3 exposure suits – under upstairs doghouse
  - Dry bags with ship documents, wallets, CC, Cash, Cell phones – Front bunk room closet
  - Extra flares – helm side cabinet and under drawer cabinets
  - Jugs of water – forward storage area (2)
  - Any food/liquid items – from galley & back deck fridge if time allows

## STOP and ASK, Do We Need to Abandon Ship

5. Drop and pull lanyard to inflate life raft over side from fly bridge, bring around to cockpit
6. Unlatch dinghy and wave runner to allow them to float if time allows
7. Decide if we need second life raft – in cockpit

## Board Life Raft from Cockpit

8. One-person boards the raft, takes on all gear & others join
9. Make sure cover gets put up
10. Keep line attached to Angelique as long as it safe to do so
11. Send text/email message of position and situation via In Reach
12. Deploy sea anchor
13. Tie life raft to dinghy & wave runner if possible. Decide if towing is possible.
14. Follow Life Raft check list and organize.
